

*DEED OF GIFT  
OF THE  
OYC DOLL-FINS  
ALL WOMEN'S REGATTA  
PERPETUAL TROPHY*

This declaration of trust made this 11th day of August, 1993 by the Oceanside Yacht Club Doll-Fins, donors, to Oceanside Yacht Club, Inc., donee, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the donors propose to encourage, foster and perpetuate the seamanship (seawomanship?) arts in the sport of sailboat racing, and to support and promote the best qualities of Corinthian yachtmanship by enhancing the spirit of friendly rivalry; and

WHEREAS, the donors desire to honor the winning Yachtswoman (women) in accordance with the terms of this declaration:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, we do hereby transfer and deliver our property, the trophy, in trust, to the donee to be hereafter known as the

ALL WOMEN'S REGATTA  
PERPETUAL TROPHY*

subject to and upon the following eligibility terms and conditions:

I. That only women who have skippered an all women crew may be eligible for the award;

II. That the trophy shall be permanently displayed in a suitable area of the clubhouse of the donee;

III. That the said trophy shall be awarded only once during any calendar year;

IV. That any sailboat competing with a woman skipper and all women crew shall be eligible;

V. That the series shall be in accordance with the racing rules of the North American Yacht Racing Union or any other rules which may supersede these in general use by a majority of the yacht clubs in the Southern California Yachting Association, or its successor;

VI. That the required minimum series must be entered and completed for eligibility; a series shall consist of two (2) or more races;

VII. That only the series finish positions shall be used for scoring;

VIII. That points shall be scored based on the series finish position; first place=3/4 points, second place=2 points, third place=3 points, etc.;

IX. That the recipient(s) shall be the woman (women) skipper(s) with the lowest total cumulative point score of the minimum two race series;

X. That said trophy shall never, under any circumstances, become the property of any individual, club or association, and shall remain the property of the donors, or their successors or appointees, and will be held, in trust, for the purposes set forth herein;

XI . That the Race Committee Chairperson, or if none, a member of the Executive Board of the OYC Doll-Fins or their assignee, no later than seven (7) days after the completion of the final race of the series, shall certify in writing to the Commodore the name of the winner;

XII. That the winner(s) of the trophy shall be announced and the trophy shall be presented at a suitable ceremony;

XIII. That the name(s) of the recipient(s), their yacht club affiliation if applicable, and the year awarded shall be affixed to the trophy permanently;

XIV. That in the event the conditions stated herein for eligibility cannot be met in any single year, this trophy shall not be awarded; and

XV. In the event that the donee shall hereafter cease to exist or function, or shall fail to comply with the terms and conditions herein provided, then the Executive Board of the OYC Doll-Fins, their successors, or their assigns, have the right and privilege to designate a yacht club, organization, or individual to hold the trophy under such terms and conditions as they, their successors or assigns, may hereinafter designate.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereunto set our hands on this 11th day of August, 1993, at Oceanside, California.
