

**DEED OF GIFT  
AND THE CONDITIONS GOVERNING  
THE  
RICK JOHNSON MEMORIAL REGATTA TROPHY**

This deed of gift made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2004, by the 2004 Oceanside Yacht Club Race Fleet, donors, to the Oceanside Yacht Club, donee, on behalf of Beth Johnson and Greg Johnson, children of Rick Johnson, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the donors wish to honor the memory of Rick Johnson, premier racer well known to many locally, throughout California and nationally. This, to be done by fostering and perpetuating the seamanship arts in the sport of sailboat racing, and to support and promote the best qualities of Corinthian Yachtmanship by enhancing the spirit of friendly rivalry and camaraderie among the participants of the regatta.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, we do hereby transfer and deed the property, the trophy, to the donee to be hereafter known as the:

“RICK JOHNSON MEMORIAL REGATTA TROPHY”

subject to the following conditions:

- I. That any skipper participating in the regatta in good standing in their respective SCYA recognized yacht club is eligible for the award;
- II. That the said trophy shall be permanently displayed at all times in a suitable area of the clubhouse of the donee;
- III. That the said trophy shall be awarded only once during any calendar year;
- IV. That the overall winner of the regatta, across all classes racing, shall be the recipient of the award of said trophy;
- V. Overall calculation to determine the winner will be based on best corrected time therefore all boats must race the same course(s) throughout the regatta;
- VI. That the regatta consist of three races, of which no less than two races will be considered a regatta, and be conducted in accordance with the racing rules of Oceanside Yacht Club in accordance with the United States Sailing Association;
- VII. That the said trophy shall never under any circumstances be transferred to any individual, club, or association, and shall remain the property of the donee in perpetuity;
- VIII. That the Commodore, or his appointed officer, shall announce the name of the recipient and shall present the trophy at a suitable ceremony upon conclusion of the regatta;

- IX. That the designation of the names of the recipient of the award of the trophy shall be made by a small plaque containing the name of the winner, the year, and the name of the winning yacht as provided for on said trophy.
- X. That an individual suitable trophy in the style of a loving cup, containing the name of the winner, the name of the regatta, the year and the name of the winning yacht be awarded to the winner;
