Dear Neil:

Regarding the three-way conversation between Bill Wiedemann, you and myself last Saturday on the subject of the "Oceanside Yacht Club Sailboat Racing Skipper Trophy" which you and Mari so very kindly donated to the Club.

I thought I would put in writing the possible errors that could be made if different people compute the scoring for this annual award. You may wish to re-write a portion of the Deed of Gift, although a copy of this letter will be attached to the Deed of Gift.

- 1) The series to be scored are those series raced in and sponsored by O.Y.C. - No series sponsored by other yacht clubs to apply.
- 2) For an O.Y.C. series to be scored there must be 5 boats entered and racing that series.
- 3) The arbitrary Fleet is to be considered a less skilled fleet of P.H.R.F. and consequently no scoring from that fleet is allowed.
- 4) Should Juniors and seniors race together in Lasers or Sabots then the senior placement in such series overall (and if all other requirements of the Deed are met) shall be scored.

I believe I have covered all the points we discussed.

DECLARATION OF TRUST
AND THE
CONDITIONS GOVERNING
THE

OCEANSIDE YACHT CLUB SAILBOAT RACING SKIPPER TROPHY

This declaration of trust made this 31st day of December, 1978, by Ar-Neil Henke, Jr., and Mariella Henke, donors, residing in Carlsbad, California, to Oceanside Yacht Club, Inc., donee, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the donors propose to encourage, foster and perpetuate the seamanship arts in the sport of sailboat racing, and to support and promote the best qualities of Corinthian Yachtmanship by enhancing the spirit of friendly rivalry among the members of the donee; and

WHEREAS, the donors desire to honor specially designated members selected from the general membership in accordance with the terms of this declaration:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises, we do hereby transfer and deliver our property, the trophy, in trust, to the donee to be hereafter known as the

"OCEANSIDE YACHT CLUB SAILBOAT RACING SKIPPER TROPHY"

subject to and upon the following eligibility terms and conditions:

I. That only flag members of the donee in good standing are eligible for the award;

II. That the said trophy shall be permanently displayed in a suitable area of the clubhouse of the donee;

III. That the said trophy shall be awarded only once during any calendar year;

IV. That any sailboat skipper of a sailboat class recognized by the donee shall be eligible;

V. That if a class is divided into skill levels, then only the highest skill division of the class shall be used for scoring. If a class is divided without regard to skill level, then only overall scoring of both divisions shall be used, if not available then the series shall not be qualified for scoring of the trophy.

VI. That each series shall be in accordance with the racing rules of the North American Yacht Racing Union or any other rules which may supersede these in general use by a majority of the yacht clubs in the Southern California Yachting Association, or its successor.

VII. That the required minimum series must be entered and completed for eligibility; a series shall consist of two (2) or more races.

VIII. That the best five (5) completed series of the year shall be used for scoring; (MINIMUM 5)

IX. That an individual skipper may be eligible for the award from as many different classes as she or he may compete in. The score to be used will be that from the class which yields the lowest cumulative number score;

X. That only the series finish positions shall be used for scoring;

XI. That points shall be scored based on the series finish position; first place = 3/4 point, second place = 2 points, third place = 3 points, etc.;

XII. That the recipient shall be the skipper with the lowest total cumulative point score of the five qualifying series;

XIII. That in the event of a tie between qualified classes the trophy shall be co-awarded;

XIV. That said trophy shall never, under any circumstances, become the property of any individual, club or association, and shall remain the property of the donors of their heirs or appointees and will be held, in trust, for the purposes set forth herein.

XV. That the Race Committee Chairperson, or if none, then the Rear Commodore of the donee, shall no later than seven (7) days after the completion of the final series for class racing sailboats certify in writing to the Commodore the name of the winner.


XVI. That the Commodore shall announce the name of the recipient and present the trophy at a suitable ceremony; and


XVII. That the name and year of the recipient shall be affixed to the trophy permanently;

XVIII. That in the event the conditions stated herein for eligibility cannot be met in any single year, the trophy shall not be awarded; and

XIX. In the event that the donee shall hereafter cease to exist or function, or shall fail to comply with the terms and conditions herein provided, then the undersigned donors, their successors or assigns, have the right and privilege to designate a yacht club, organization, or individual to hold the trophy under such terms and conditions as they, their successors or assigns, may hereinafter designate.

We have hereunto set our hands on this 31st day of December, 1978, at Carlsbad, California.
