NOTICE OF RACE



1.0 Rules:

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009 - 2012 as adopted by the United States Sailing Association (USSA), the Class Rules of the PHRF of Southern California (PHRF), the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. OYC is the organizing authority for the Oceanside Yacht Club Charity Regatta benefiting the Elizabeth Hospice Foundation of North County San Diego.

2.0 Eligibility and Entry:

2.1 The regatta is open to members of yacht clubs and sailing associations recognized by the Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA) or US SAILING. Yachts in the Cruising Class without a PHRF certificate will be accepted and will be assigned a rating by the race committee. The regatta is open to the following One-Design classes: Holder 20, Capri 25, Catalina 27, J24, J80, Olson 30, J120 and yachts holding a current valid Southern California PHRF certificate rating between -18 and 240. Other interested classes are invited to enter if they have at least 3 boats and contact Race Committee by July 30, 2011. Yachts in PHRF Classes must have a valid 2011 PHRF certificate.

2.2 Ratings: Southern California PHRF Buoy and Random Leg Ratings will be used without area adjustments.

2.3 **Entries are due by 1700 on Monday, August 8.** Entry fee is \$50.00. Acceptance of late entries is at the discretion of the Race Chairman and will be subject to an additional late entry fee of \$25.00. All PHRF and One Design competitors must **include a copy of the yacht's 2011 rating certificate** with your entry. Failure to do so will penalize you at 3 seconds per mile deducted from your published rating.

2.4 Classes: PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker and Cruising Classes will be established by the Race Committee. Cruising Class boats may not use spinnakers, gennakers are permitted.

4.0 Races and Racing Areas:

4.1 Four races are scheduled for One-Design and PHRF Spinnaker & Non-Spinnaker Fleets with three windward/leeward races on Saturday and one random leg race on Sunday.

4.2 Three random leg races are scheduled for the Cruising Class Fleets with two races on Saturday and one race on Sunday.

4.3 All PHRF fleets and Cruising Class will race south of the harbor entrance.



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5.0 Sailing Instructions, Registration and Competitor's Meeting:

- 5.1 A race package including Sailing Instructions will be available after 1700 hrs on Friday, August 12, 2011. Any participant registering after Monday, August 8 must register with the Regatta Office between 1700 hrs and 1900 hrs on Friday, August 12. Pre-registration is encouraged. A competitor's meeting will be held at OYC on Saturday, August 13 at 0930 hrs.
- 5.2 Changes in Sailing Instructions: Any changes to this NOR or Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Race Notice Board on the OYC Deck by 1000 hrs each race day.
- 5.3 Class Breaks, Class Flags and Order of Start: Class Breaks, Class Flags and Order of Start will be announced at the Competitor's meeting and posted on the OYC Race Notice Board by 1000 hrs on Saturday, August 13.
- 5.4 Pre-Race Check-in: All boats must check in each day with the OYC Race Committee boat when it is anchored in the starting area displaying a code "L" flag and must be recognized prior to the warning signal for the first start. Any boat failing to comply will be scored DNS.



6.0 Scoring:

- 6.1 The Low-Point Scoring System of the RRS 2009-20012, Appendix A will apply with one throw-out for the One Design and PHRF (Spinnaker) fleets. Two races shall constitute a series.

7.0 Safety:

- 7.1 All yachts entered must comply with the equipment requirements of the USCG and of Category IV as defined by the Southern California PHRF.



8.0 Berthing:

- 8.1 **Yachts requiring a berth must have sent their registration or have contacted OYC 760-722-5751 by July 29 to confirm availability.** Yachts will be docked, possibly rafted, at either the end of I-dock or the Jolly Roger Restaurant docks near OYC and accommodated on a first come-first served basis. Upon arrival, yachts should hail OYC on VHF Channel 68 or via phone at 760-722-5751.

10.0 Trophies:

- 10.1 Trophies will be awarded in each class based upon the number of entries and awarded on Sunday, August 14.

11.0 Charity Cup Eligibility:

- 11.1 Participants in the OYC Charity Regatta are eligible for the Charity Cup consisting of the BCYC Leukemia Cup, DWYC Leukemia Cup, OYC Charity Regatta and DPYC Richard Henry Dana Charity Regatta based on the provisions in the current Charity Cup Deed of Gift.



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
