Notice of Race
St. Patrick's Day Shannon Regatta
4 Races – Saturday, March 12, 2011

General Information: Safety equipment and crew for PHRF Category 4 races shall be required. Refer to the most current PHRF rules, which list required equipment and require a minimum crew of 2. Entrants not complying with the Category 4 minimum crew requirements will not be recognized as a race entrant by the Race Committee upon check in at the start of race.

Entries: A signed entry must be filed for each boat in agreement with the notice of race and sailing instructions for each event. The individual signing the entry will be responsible for the boat throughout the event to which it applies.

Rules: This event will be governed by OYC sailing instructions, which will be made available at the skippers meeting.

Classes: Class breaks will be announced at the skipper's meeting. At the discretion of the Principal Race Officer, three or more boats may create a class.

Eligibility: PHRF entrants must have or place a valid PHRF of Southern California rating certificate on file at OYC. Entrants must sign an entry form to release OYC from any liability and to agree to abide by the rules identified above.

Registration: Promptly between 0930 to 1000 hours on March 12 at the OYC clubhouse. Late registration is discouraged but may be accepted at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer. Registration must be completed at OYC prior to racing on the water. There will be no on-the-water registration.

Fee: \$15 for OYC members. \$25 for non-OYC members. A \$1 discount will be given to members of the US Sailing Association upon presentation of a current USSA membership card.

Skippers meeting: Promptly at 1000 hours on March 12 at the OYC clubhouse.

Start times: First warning signal will be at 1155 hours. First start will be at 1200. The starting order will be announced at the Skippers' meeting.

Courses: Courses chart will be made available at the skippers meeting. Courses will be sailed in waters in the vicinity of the Oceanside Pier.

Results and Trophies: Results will be posted at OYC after the day's racing activities. Trophies will be awarded at the OYC clubhouse after the races on March 12.
