



2010 Twilight Series Notice of Race

May 19 Wednesday - Registration & Skippers Meeting

Series 1	May 26 – June 16
Series 2	June 23 – July 14
Series 3	July 28 – August 18 (no race July 21)
Awards	August 18

General Information: Safety equipment and crew for PHRF Category 4 races shall be required. Refer to the most current PHRF rules, which list required equipment and require a minimum crew of 2. Entrants not complying with the Category 4 minimum crew requirements will not be recognized as a race entrant by the Race Committee upon check in at the start of race.

Rules: This event will be governed by OYC sailing instructions, which will be made available at the skippers meeting.

Classes: PHRF, OCF and Novice. OCF and Novice classes will be non-spinnaker only. Three or more boats will constitute a class.

Eligibility: PHRF entrants must have or place a valid PHRF of Southern California rating certificate on file at OYC. Entrants must sign an entry form to release OYC from any liability and to agree to abide by the rules identified above.

Registration: At 6:00 PM on Wednesday, May 19, 2010 at Oceanside Yacht Club. Subsequent registration must be completed by 4:45 PM on any race day.

Fee:

OYC Members - \$50 for the overall series or \$25 for any individual series (or portion thereof)

Non-OYC Members - \$75 for the overall series or \$30 for any individual series (or portion thereof)

Upon presentation of membership card, members of USSA will receive an additional \$5 discount for the overall series or a \$2 discount for any individual series.

Skippers meeting: At 7:00 PM on Wednesday, May 19, 2010 (immediately following registration) at Oceanside Yacht Club.

Start times: The first warning signal will be at 5:55 PM, and the first start will be at 6:00 PM. There will be five minutes between starts, beginning Novice, then OCF, then PHRF classes. It is strongly recommended that entrants be on the water in the vicinity of the start line by 5:45 PM. If there are no entrants in Novice class, then OCF will start first, with PHRF classes moving to an earlier start.

Courses: Course chart will be made available at the skippers meeting. Courses will be sailed in waters in the vicinity of the Oceanside Pier.

Scoring: The low point scoring system A4 described in the specified Racing Rules of Sailing will be used. There will be no throw-outs for the individual Series 1, 2 or 3, but there will be 3 throw-outs for the entire Twilight Series overall scoring. Entrants must participate in a minimum of four races in the overall series to be eligible for an overall Twilight Series trophy.

Results and Trophies: Results will be posted at OYC, in the Twixt newsletter, and on the club's website, <http://www.oceansideyc.com/>, subsequent to each race. First-place trophies will be awarded at OYC following each race and for each class at the end of each individual series. Trophies for the overall Twilight Series will be awarded on August 18, 2010 at a ceremony following that day's race.
